Just an FYI: In 2014 we paid out approximately \$45,000.00 in end of season points monies including the MN Sweep.

In 2015 (this year) we anticipate about \$50,000.00 in end of season points monies including the MN sweep.



Items that go in effect for the 2016 NTPA season:

General Rules:

- 1. No crew member, helper or anyone else allowed behind, in front of or within 5 ft of the front of the sled (buckboard) or chain area while a vehicle is backing up to, hooking or unhooking from the sled other than the hook-unhook personnel or the track officials.
- 2. No crew member, helper or anyone else besides the driver allowed within 5 ft of the perimeter of the weigh scale while a vehicle is being weighed. Crew members may add or subtract weights then step back before the scale person reads the corrected weight.
- 3. Competition vehicles may not have any headlights or lights of any kind or any color that are aimed forward as to impair the Flagman's vision while traveling down the track.
- 4. The use of electronic control devises for ignition timing. I.e. (MSD 8973, Power Grid, Six Shooter). Is Not Allowed in any division that uses spark ignition
- 5. All Lenco-type planetary transmissions, including reverser must be covered with a SFI 4.1 Spec Blanket.

SS, Pro, Lgt Pro, Lim Pro, SF tractor classes: NTPA will allow air bags and/or coil over shocks on the front of tractor as long as they cannot be adjusted from the seat.

Pro Farm rules: 20.8 radial tire is allowed

Semi Division: Drawbar height was changed to 18 inches.

WPI Sled Rules: The use of cell phone for any reason (talk, text, photos or video) during a competition run down the track is strictly prohibited.

***Effective immediately: ***

1. All divisions, SFI 6.2 or 6.3 aluminum belhousings must have a valid and current SFI sticker on it from the manufacture before being allowed to compete in the 2015 season.

Note: This only applies to aluminum belhousings.

2. The protest fee for fuel and/or water and electronics testing has been raised to \$1000.00 due to lab costs
